From the North: Take 95 South to Exit 17 Elmwood Avenue. Turn left at the bottom of the exit. Make a U-turn in the turning lane on the right side of Elmwood Avenue into Roger Williams Park. Bear right. The Casino will be directly ahead.

From the South: Take 95 North to Exit 16/Route 10 towards Cranston. Take Elmwood Avenue Exit, turn left at the end of the exit onto Elmwood Avenue and drive .2 miles. Entrance to Roger Williams Park will be on the right and then bear right. The Casino will be directly ahead.
